Kleinburg Nobleton Soccer Club

1999 & 1998 combined/U11 and U12, girls only

- 1- 6 teams participate in this age group
- 2- Up to 18 players to be selected per team
- 3- 11 vs. 11, including off side rules
- 4- Games are played on a Senior field
- 5- One night for practice and one night for game per week. Focus on skill development during practice night. The game will be 2 X 30 minute halves with a 5 minute break in between. All games to have scheduled referees.

K.N.S.C. HOUSE LEAGUE RULES

1. SHIN GUARDS and SOCCER SHOES are a must at each soccer game for all ages. Each player must participate a minimum of 50% of the total playing time.
2. HANDBALL if unintentional, play on, if intentional (in the goal area) a penalty kick is awarded. If outside of goal area a direct kick is awarded from area where handball took place.
3. For U4, U5, U6, U7 and U8 there will be no throw-ins, **ONLY KICK-INS** (to develop more touches on the ball and improve passing and passing vision.
4. Maximum number of players on the field at any one time per teams is 3 players for U4 to U6, 4 players for U7, 5 players for U8 (including GK) and for U9 & up either 7 or 11 players (including GK) depending on the field size. 7 for Junior field and 11 for Senior field.
5. Length of games with referees- U8- 2 X 20 min, U9 to U12- 2 X 30 min., U13 to U16- 2 X 40 min. Each with a 5 min. break in between
6. Unlimited substitution during stoppage of play and/or upon the signal of the referee.
7. The goalkeeper cannot handle the ball (with their hands) outside the goal area.
8. Goal kicks may be taken from any point inside the goal area.
9. PENALTY SHOTS are to be taken from a 10-yard spot directly in front of the mid-point of the goal, instead of the normal penalty spot of 12 yards.
10. The referee shall explain infractions to the offending players.
11. Coaches, managers, team officials and parents shall not criticize game officials at any time and shall encourage the same attitude amongst all players and supporters.
12. The ball is to be considered 'frozen' immediately, when the referee in his discretion, considers that it is 'in the possession' of the goalkeeper.
13. On the taking of a goal kick no opponent is to be closer to the goal area marking than 10 yards.
14. During the regular season games, one coach referees the first half of the game and the other coach referees the last half of the game. This applies for all other age groups, where a referee is normally used but fails to show after having waited 10 minutes.
15. GAME SHEETS are required by all age groups U8 and up. The game sheet must be completed properly and signed by the referee and coaches and faxed to the Club. Only registered players will be allowed to play.
16. Players with open wounds or blood stained uniforms will not be allowed to play.
17. Cancellation and rescheduling of games due to weather or other reasons will be coordinated by the House League Director.
18. During the game, parents and spectators are to be on the opposite side of the field to the players and coach.
19. No one is to stand at the ends of the field (behind the goal) during the game.
20. Off side rule in effect for all games played on a Senior field
21. ALWAYS PLAY FOR FUN

PARENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT

The Parent's signature on the Registration Agreement on the Player's House League Registration Form for the current year Constitutes the full agreement of BOTH of the player's parents AND of any other personal guests to abide by the following Code Of Conduct at the field:

1. We will remember that children participate to have fun, that this is a recreational program and that the game is for youth, not for adults
2. We will teach our child to play by the rules, and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility
3. We (and our guests) will be positive role models for our child and encourage good sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game
4. We (and our guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, parent or player such as booing and taunting or using profane language or gestures.
5. We will respect the Referee and his/her authority during games and will never criticize, contradict or interfere with Referees or Coaches at the game field. We will take time to speak with Coaches privately if we have any concerns or complaints.
6. Any child who is young enough to normally require adult supervision must be supervised by their parent, or a designated guardian at all times at the field and should never be left at the field alone with the team. Neither Coaches nor any team official is responsible for the supervision of any child.

We also agree that if we fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, we may be subject to disciplinary action, which could include a ban from attending games or expulsion of our child from the Club
